SUBJ: FEATURES NOT AVAILABLE UNDER TYPYST VERSION 2.7

The features listed in this memo are available only to users operating TYPYST 2.8 or later; they are not available to users operating TYPYST Version 2.7 under IRIS Revision 7.5. These features involve printers and justification.

TYPYST Version 2.7 under IRIS Revision 7.5 has the following limitations:

- The "Printer Type" NEC 10 is not supported; therefore, NEC 3510, 5510 and 7710 printers may not be used.
- The SEMI class of printers is not available. Only printers classed as dumb or intelligent may be used.
- Dumb printers do not recognize or obey the directives \DOUBLE or \SINGLE. (Dumb printers do not recognize or obey \ONE&H under any version of TYPYST.)
- When justification is in effect, slightly overlength lines can not be compressed and therefore will not justify.
- Lines containing the \BS, \UP and \DN directives may not be correctly justified.
