Here are some IRIS tips from our Customer Support Department:

- Page 5-64 of the IRIS R8 Installation and Configuration Manual shows three zeros are recommended in the "delay after special chars" list when setting up \$LPT. In practice, these three zeros are usually not needed and, in some cases, may cause spurious characters and other garbage to print, especially on letter quality printers.
- Do not make STYLUS discsub 151 memory resident under IRIS 8.2; this will avoid corrupting memory and possibly crashing the system. A correction for this problem is due to be released shortly.
- 3. If you have an IRIS 7.2 system, please note that IRIS 7.2 has problems using \$MMUX with the current version of the 310 multiplexer. IRIS 7.5 and later systems do not have this problem.
- 4. Customers using the Trident T-302 disk drives should note that, although an IRIS system using the 700 or 710 disk controller runs fine on older T-302 drives, recent T-302 drives seem to have a newer "logic Q" board that is not compatible.
- 5. While \$CTUS is working fine on most systems, there are a few systems where it fails to run properly and causes system TRAPs; we are investigating the problem.
- 6. The revision of the tech memo that tells you everything you need to know about reading 20MB quarter-inch streamer tapes on 45MB drives is not yet complete. In the interim, if you have a 45MB drive, the easiest course may be to specify 45MB tapes when ordering software from POINT 4.
- 7. LU/5 utilities have become a standard part of the IRIS operating system. When you receive 8.2C or later revisions, please remember to make the 8.2C LU/5 utilities part of your 8.2C system.
